<i>Mission</i>	Strengthen and align citywide data ecosystems and cross-sector collaborations to improve expanded learning access and impact for all Tulsa youth
<i>Definition of Data & Impact</i>	Data includes any information collected on OST participants, staff, or programs, including demographics, attendance, behavior, assessment results and program quality. Increased use and analysis of data will lead to greater positive impacts on youth.

Strategic Direction

- Select a data system that can be used citywide by both schools and OST program providers, collecting consistent data measures, increasing analysis and usage of data, and ultimately resulting in positive impacts for students
- Support the other Design Teams in their collection of data through surveys, questionnaires, and observation
- Establish data collection processes and procedures to ensure consistent and reliable data
- Develop data standards and coordinate, collaborate, and train on how to collect, analyze, and utilize data
